The Add-um Games



Number of

Players: 2 – 3

Content: Adding 0, 1, or 2 to one-digit numbers.

Materials: One gameboard, 20 chips for each player

Two special dice

Level A: One die numbered 0, 0, 1, 1, 2, 2

One die numbered 0, 1, 1, 2, 2, 3

Level B: One die numbered 0, 0, 1, 1, 2, 2

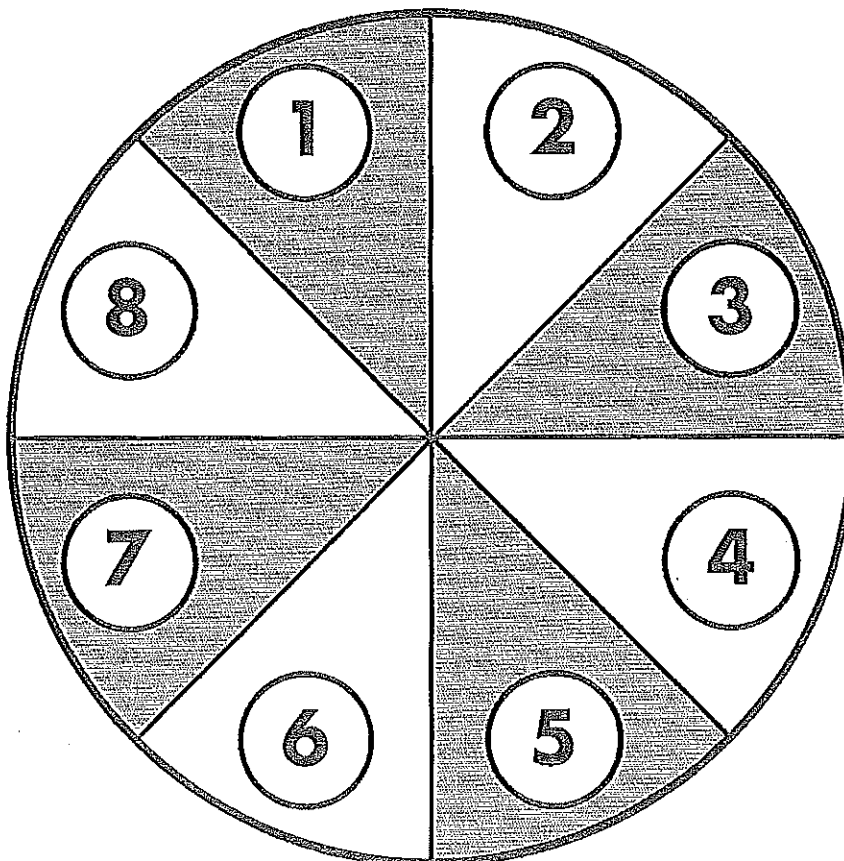
One octahedral die, numbered 1 – 8 (or a spinner numbered 1 – 8)

How to

Play:

1. Each player rolls the dice. The player with the largest sum goes first.
2. When it is your turn, roll the dice. Say the sum, and cover a numeral matching the sum with one of your chips.
3. If all the numerals showing your sum are covered, you lose your turn.
4. When there are two players, the winner is the first player to get five chips in a row, horizontally, vertically or diagonally. With three players, the winner is the first to get four in a row.
