

# Salute

## Card Game

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### Need:

- one deck of cards with the face cards removed
- 3 students



- The three students sit in a triangle facing the center of the triangle. One student is the "Caller", and the other two are the "Saluters."
- The deck of cards is placed in the center of the triangle.
- The two "Saluters" draw a card and do not look at their own card. They each put their own card on their forehead and "salute" the other player. Thus, the other player can see the opposite player's card, but not his/her own card.
- The caller calls out the sum of the cards on the foreheads.
- The person, who can figure out what number is on their OWN forehead correctly, gets to take both cards.
- Play continues until the deck of cards from the middle is gone.

\*\*\* The winner is the person who has the most cards in his /her own pile. \*\*\*
